OUR STORY...

WIN President Peter Van Breda and Executive Director Gabriella Van Breda have deep roots in education. They both hold postgraduate degrees and have spent the last thirty-eight years of their ministry lives promoting education. Firstly with their children's school in South Africa, later with the establishment of a ministry training center to train leaders for worldwide mission service throughout Africa and now with the establishment of The New International University.

Their educational story began in South Africa in 1985. It was the year Calvary Christian College was established. This was at a time when the apartheid regime had enacted and enforced policies of segregation for children of different racial groups.



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As pastors with an already established multiracial congregation they refused to accept the status guo and together with two other churches, forged ahead with their plans for Christian education for children of all racial groups. This was in clear defiance of the South African authorities. Under threat of imprisonment, they refused to close their schools. It is their view that the decision they made back then began their crusade to encourage and be part of ensuring that education would always be part of their ministry mandate. Since then they have worked wherever and whenever the opportunity arose to bring education to leaders in the emerging world. They believed and still believe this to be in keeping with their values to act justly, to love mercy and to walk humbly before God.

Thus even in the face of threatened imprisonment they resisted an oppressive regime and won. Calvary Christian College is still in existence today and continues to be one of the premier multi-racial Christian schools in South Africa with a 100% high school graduation rate. Thus the beliefs of these two WIN founders, regarding the value and importance of education for all people, form the foundation for the mission of World Impact Network and now TNIU.

WIN'S mission and vision can be summed up in a few sentences. It is to deliver affordable Christian values-based education to the people of the world and in particular to leaders at work in their communities. The vision of WIN is to forge partnership with diverse stakeholders in various countries as the opportunity arises, to maximize efforts and minimize costs, thus making available much needed affordable accredited degrees to students in these contexts.





Please pray for our visits to Thailand, Myanmar, Italy, Albania and the Ukraine in early 2020. God has given us the opportunity to establish partnerships with local Bible colleges and ministry training centers who want accredited higher theological education for their students.

Many governments are now requiring that leaders have a university degree in order to pastor a church. Students in these nations recognize that having a degree will give them added credibility in their communities enabling them to be more effective in their work of spreading the Gospel and serving the needs of their constituents.

These are exciting times for TNIU!
